Competition Staff Duty Policy for National Championships

Head Judge – Freestyle

- Ensure that sufficient score sheets, pens, clip boards etc are ready each day
- Supervise to ensure judging is fair, accurate and consistent
- Ensure that competitors are identified correctly (CLO or Beach Marshal should advise)
- Make judgments on breach of rules (in conjunction with Technical Director if necessary)
- Deliver (by runner) all score sheets to the Head score keeper
- Implement roster of judges and time keepers/ flag marshals
- Immediately notify Technical Director and CLO if any changes to draw or program are required
- Submit all score to AKSA for National rankings

Head Judge – Waves

- As per freestyle head judge
- Add top three wave scores from each judge and notify the CLO of results

Competitor Liaison Officer (CLO)

- Primary point of contact for competitors
- Notify head judge of the kites each competitor can be identified by. Liaise with beach marshal to delegate this task if required if required.
- Update master draw and program
- Liaise with head judge to ensure accuracy of both draw & programs
- Notify Technical Director of any issues including changes to draw or program

Time Keepers and Flag Marshals

- Work to the program unless directed otherwise by the head judge

Beach Marshals

- Coordinate the safe launch and recovery of kites
- Assist CLO in identification of competitors and communicating this to head judges
- Enforce any local body restrictions
- Keep members of the general public out of competitor and official areas

Head Score Keeper

- Ensure accurate timely calculation of scores from freestyle judging sheets



- Notify CLO and freestyle head judge of results so that their copies of the draw can be maintained
- Implement roster of score keepers
- Maintain copy of draw and program
- Secure all original copies of score sheets
- Notify Technical Director of any issues that may arise
- Assist the Technical Director in calculating the overall combined freestyle and wave scores, publish results
